



#### **LENTEN REGULATIONS**

**Abstinence:** All Catholics who have reached their 14<sup>th</sup> year are bound to abstain from meat totally on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent.

Fasting: The law of fasting obliges all Catholics who are between the ages of 18-59 inclusive. On a day of Fast, those who are obliged by this law, may eat only one full meal and two partial meals (all meatless), unless dispensed or excused by reason of illness or special circumstance.


The observance of the laws of Fast & Abstinence is a serious obligation from which no Catholic will be lightly excused.
