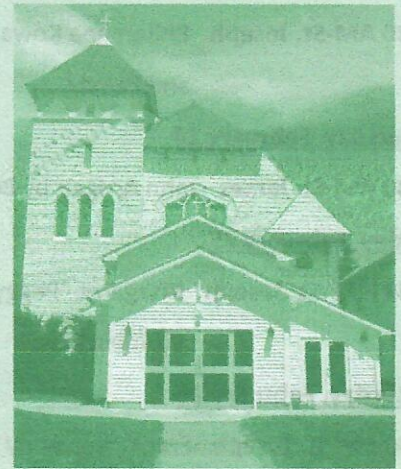

YOUNG ADULT RETREAT

The Diocesan Offices for Parish Life and Vocations are sponsoring a retreat for young adults (aged 18-35) on Friday, March 25. LENTEN REGULATIONS

Abstinence: All Catholics who have reached their 14th year are bound to abstain from meat totally on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent.

Fasting: The law of fasting obliges all Catholics who are between the ages of 18-59 inclusive. On a day of Fast, those who are obliged by this law, may eat only one full meal and two partial meals (all meatless), unless dispensed or excused by reason of illness or special circumstance.

The observance of the laws of Fast & Abstinence is a serious obligation from which no Catholic will be lightly excused.

WINTER CEMETERY POLICIES

Cemetery visitations are prohibited when roads and graves are covered with snow. It is often challenging to navigate cemetery roads with plow trucks and we seek to exercise caution in not damaging grass and, most importantly, graves and their markers. We also wish to protect the safety of each of you and ask everyone to exercise prudence in your visitations in general. We do not want any injuries to occur or vehicles to be stuck in snow.

DIOCESE OF SCRANTON: GUIDELINES FOR PUBLIC MASSES DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

1. The Diocese of Scranton is **strongly recommending** that all parishioners wear a mask while attending

Mass – regardless of vaccination status. As Catholics, we have a responsibility to protect our friends and neighbors and mask wearing remains an important mitigation tool against community spread.

2. In order to safeguard our community, all Priests, Deacons, Extraordinary Ministers, and Altar Servers must wear masks during the distribution of Holy Communion.
3. Anyone who is sick should stay home and participate in the celebration of Mass through Catholic Television or a parish livestream Mass. In addition, anyone displaying COVID-19 symptoms (fever, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, headache, or muscle pain) should not attend Mass in-person.
4. Please use hand sanitizer upon entering the church.
5. The Sign of Peace will be celebrated without physical contact.
6. Distribution of the Precious Blood remains suspended at this time.
