I am Fr. Arun Lakra, HGN (Heralds of Good News a Missionary society), and I was born on April 18, 1984 in India. I have four elder brothers and two elder sisters, and I am the youngest child in the family. My parents are deceased. The zeal to follow Christ and strong faith was planted in me by my devoted parents in my early childhood. I joined seminary in 2004 after my tenth grade. After long twelve years of discernment of God's will, I was ordained as a priest on May 3, 2015. My first appointment as priest was in the Herald Bhavan, minor seminary as vice-Rector and dean of studies. In 2016, I was appointed as principal of the St. Jude's Junior College.

I came to Scranton on October 10, 2019, and was assigned to Freeland, Our Lady of Immaculate Conception and Good Shepherd Parish, Drums. It was a thrilling experience for me to be in the parish for the first time. I was transferred to St. Rose of

Lima and our Lady of Mount Carmel, Carbondale, on August 2, 2021. It was another new adventure and thrilling experience with different ministries. I enjoyed doing my very best with my sacramental and pastoral ministries with (now) Bishop Jeffrey Walsh, Fr. Seth, Deacon Michael, all staff members, and parishioners. I am very grateful to all of them for everything. Now I am here in Forest City in your midst to be with you and to serve God together. I am extremely happy to be with you and am looking forward in making our parishes more vibrant and deeply rooted with faith in Christ. I request all of you to keep me in your constant prayers. I also assure you of my constant prayer. Once again, I say a big thanks to all of you for everything.


